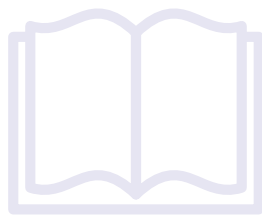




We don't believe gender stereotypes should limit our identities, experiences and life chances.

- ✓ Speak up – challenge biases and sexist behaviour

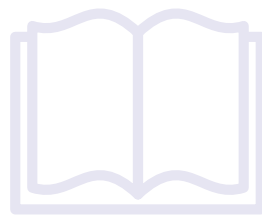




We don't believe gender stereotypes should limit our identities, experiences and life chances.
